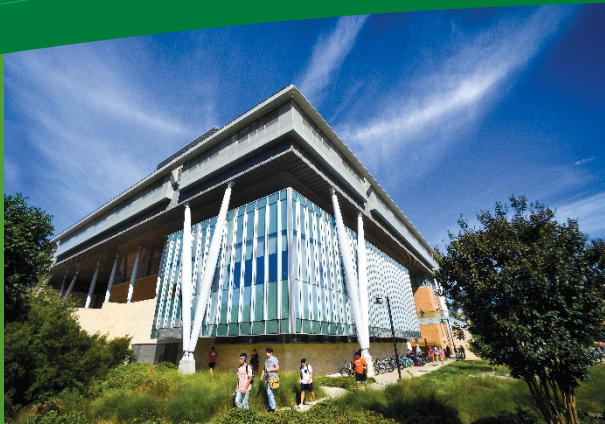

### VPRI Seed Grant Opportunity

The Division of Research and Innovation (DRI) is now accepting applications for its annual Research Seed Grants (RSG).

RSGs are intended for scholarly and creative activities where it is difficult to find external sponsors. RSGs also serve as a funding mechanism to jumpstart research activity to collect preliminary data or conduct pilot studies to help with seeking larger external funding within one year.

RSGs can be awarded up to \$10,000 from DRI by the department (or college or institute). Seed funding is intended to enable research that produces funding of extramural sponsored programs later down the line.

The VPRI encourages the use of RSGs for collaborative and interdisciplinary research. Please take note that this is not intended to support single Principal Investigator (PI) projects.

The deadline to submit applications is Friday, November 12, 2021.
